

Creating a Research Plan

Identify your goal/question

Take an inventory of what is known

Consider the records that may answer the research question/what records are available for the concerned time or place

Write down the steps to answer the question given the available records

Adjust plan as needed





Results of Census Search

- O What information do we learn from this record?
- O What would the next step be?



Example of a full research plan

- Write down steps to answer the question with available records
 - Search the 1891 England Census for a James Woodland born in about 1827 in Netherbury,
 Dorset. This will give his birthplace and names of his wife/possible children.
 - Search other census records, going backwards until he's no longer found with his wife. Use the names of his wife and kids to know which one is him.
 - Search parish registers for a marriage record between him and his wife, this should give the name/occupation of his father.
 - Find any other available census records before his marriage to learn the name of his mother and potential siblings.
 - Search for a baptism in the year of his birth in Netherbury, Dorset to confirm or learn name of mother.
 - To learn his mother's maiden name, search parish registers for a marriage between James's parents.

Writing it up/ Reporting

How do I know this is correct?

What questions might someone else have?

Are there any contradictions?

Is my reason statement clear and concise?

Is my tone professional and neutral?
