

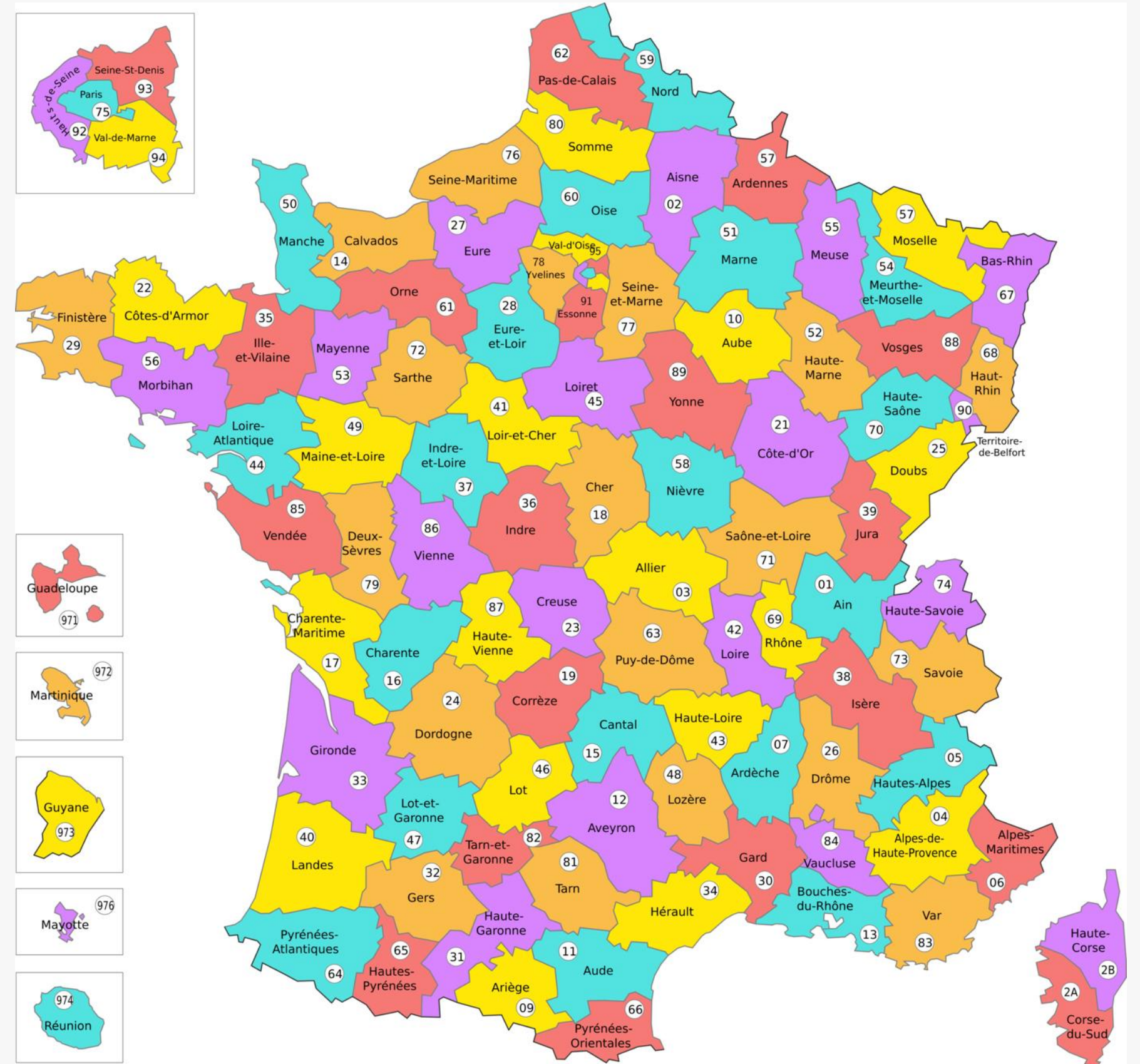

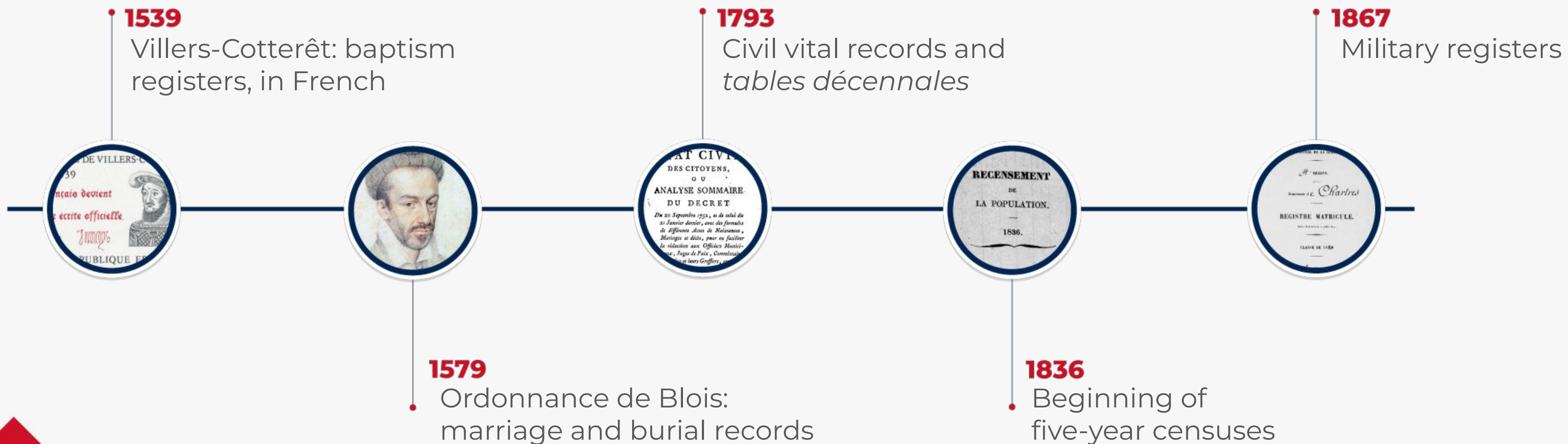

France's decentralized archives: the *départements*

- 95 *départements* (counties)
- 36,000 (!) *communes* (municipalities)
- Created in 1790, with some changes
- BMD, censuses are online, but *unindexed* at the ADs

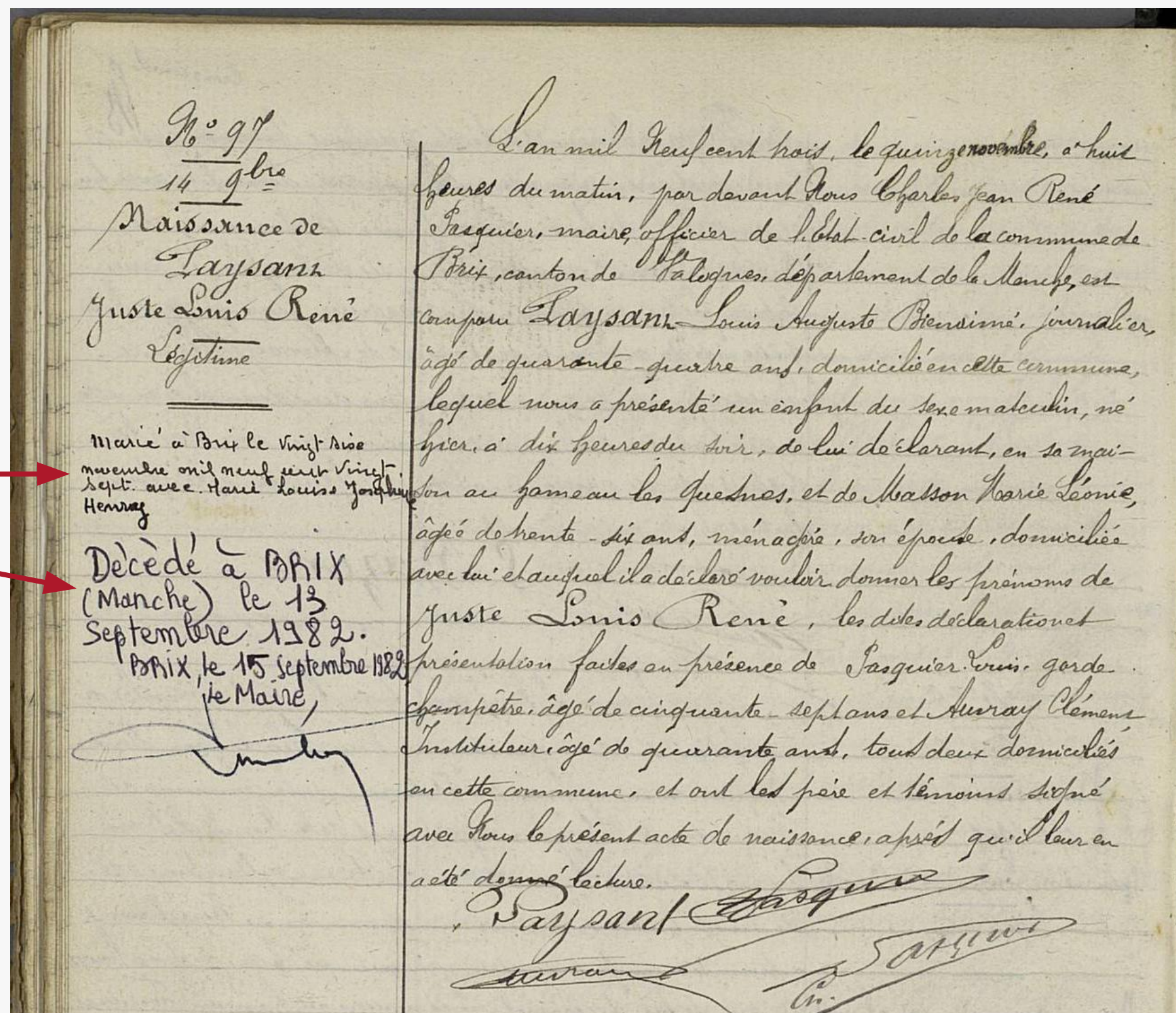


French vital records: key dates



Principal sources: *l'Etat-civil*

- Births, marriages, deaths
- Marginal notes are key!



Principal sources: Censuses

- Every five years starting in 1836
- Many are still unindexed, but if you know the municipality you can inspect the pages

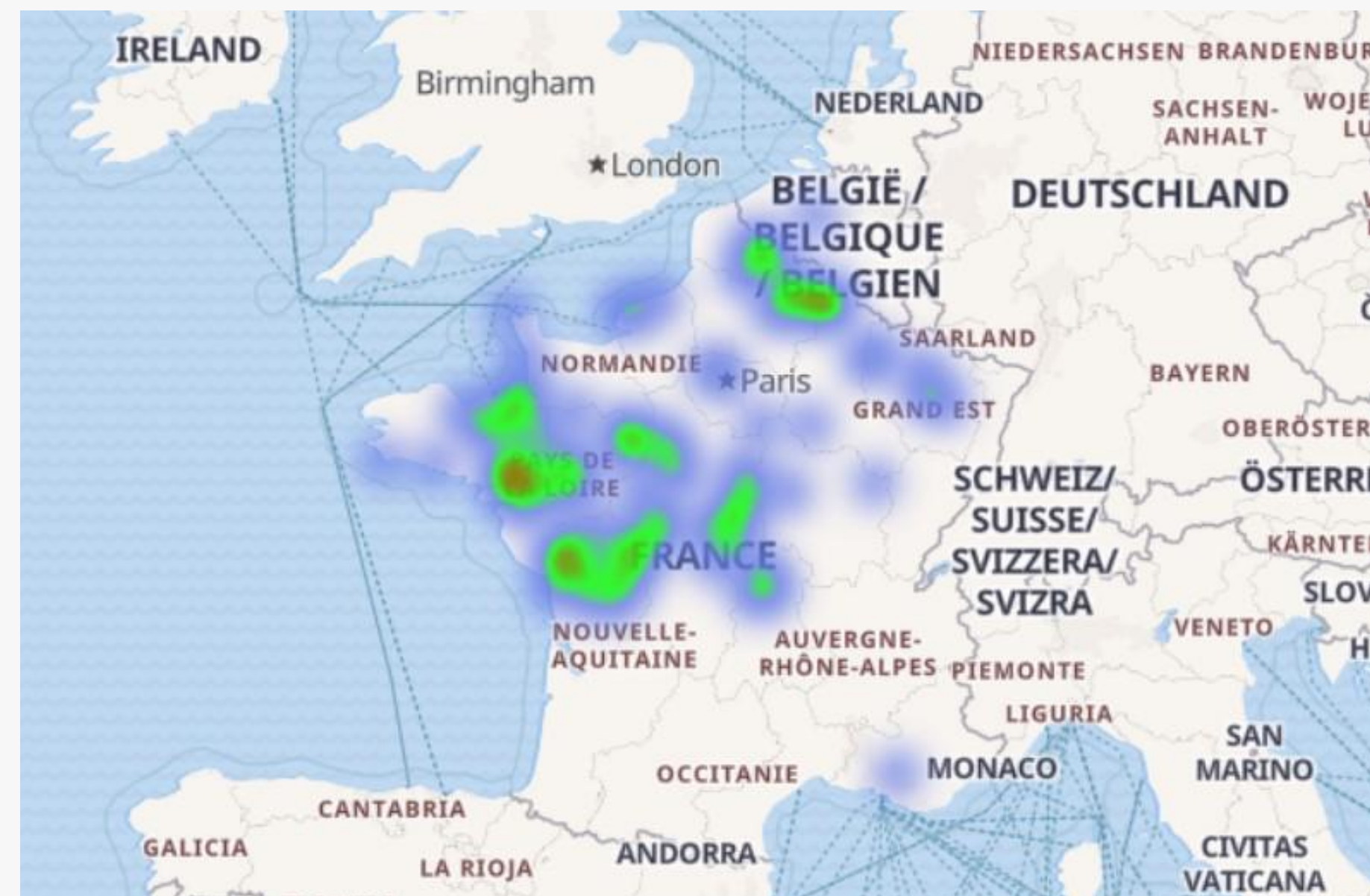

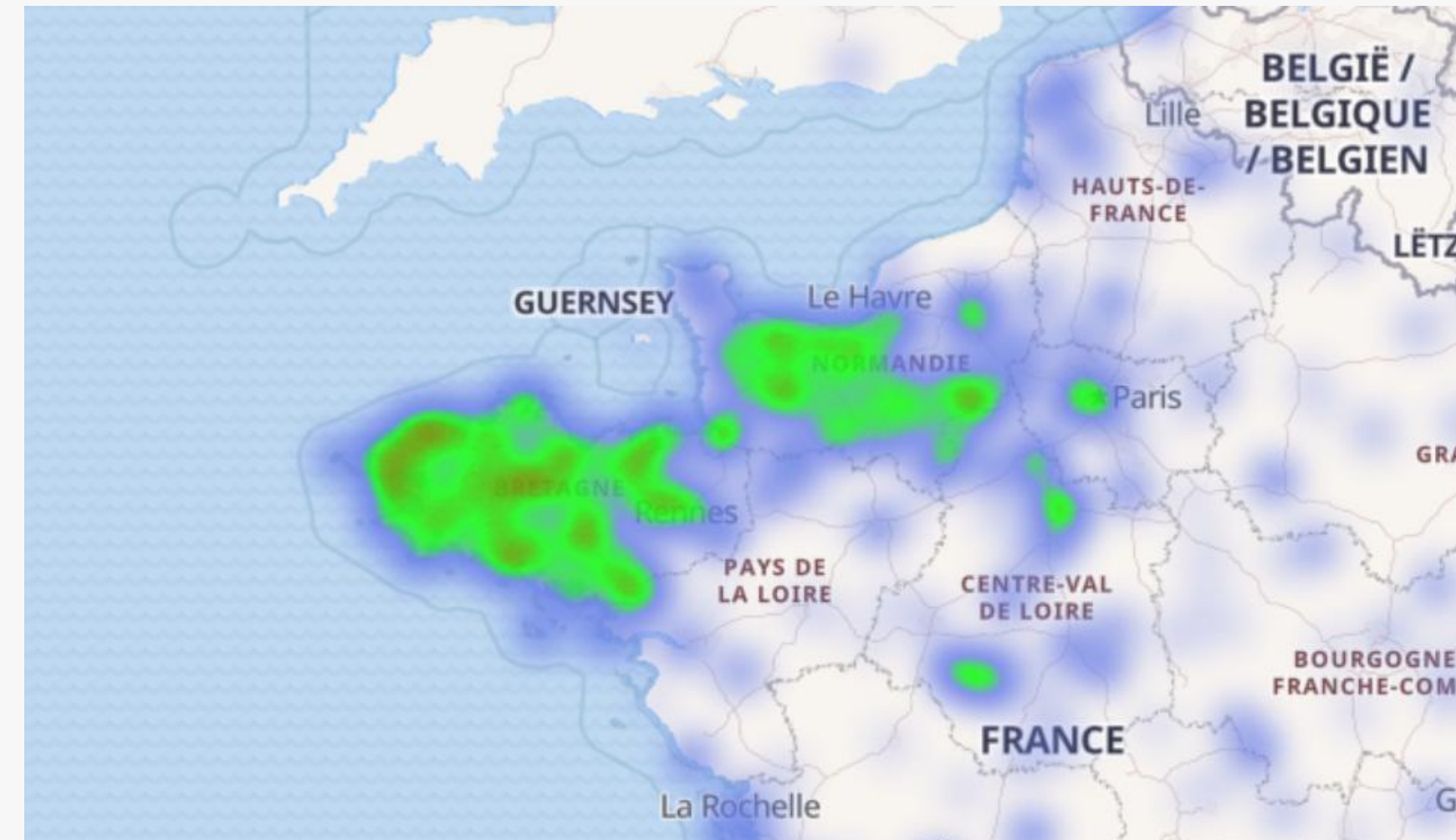
- Family names from the 12th century on
- The world's record for number of last names vs. population!
- But: spelling variants...



Geneanet's Origin of Last Names heatmap for the family name GAUVIN

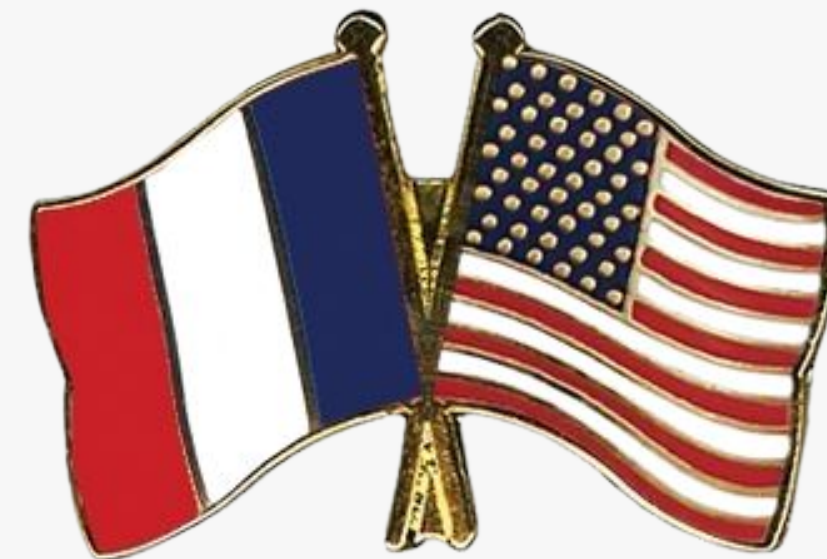
... and regional given names in France

- Some first names are very popular in certain regions
- From the 18th century, individuals often had two or even three given names
- Registrars have their say about given names (!)



The first name Tanguy is widespread in Brittany and Normandy!

French vs. American genealogy



- French archives go way back to the 17th century!
- Standardized cote (reference series) codes
- Free online access to (unindexed) archives, with privacy limitations
- Death records (even very recent) are easy to obtain in France, but are without cause of death
- Cemetery concessions are of limited duration, perhaps no grave anymore
- DNA tests remain illegal in France :-(
- 1.6 million family names, regional first names -> great clues!

Let's research a Frenchman: Charles Michel FRANÇOIS

- Born between 1880 and 1890, but we don't know where in France. Spouse: Hortense
- Search results: several family trees, his military record, birth records
- Dates, *département*, municipalities, and a second spouse!



- 1E0750_008 = the cote (reference)
- 1913 = the year; most reels span a range
- Acte 11 = the certificate number in the register
- Page(s) 6 sur 11 = the register page and total number of pages in the digitized reel with the acte

Visiting the *Archives Départementales*



Archives Départementales de la Manche (50) in Saint-Lô

- 95 to choose from, so plan your visit:
inventories, contact
- Unusual treasures can be found!
 - archives notariales
 - unpublished censuses
 - tables de successions
- Take photos with your smartphone (usually)

The *Tables Décennales*

- From 1790 on, index every ten years of births, marriages, deaths
- The original finding aid of vital records registrars
- Useful if you know the municipality, but not the date
- Find other family members!

- Promotions, medals
- Legal matters
- Geneanet's *Genealogy Library*

Alsace-Lorraine

- A region between France and Germany which has changed administration five times
- Records in Latin, German, or French - sometimes for the same person!
- But kept in the municipality (+ADs)

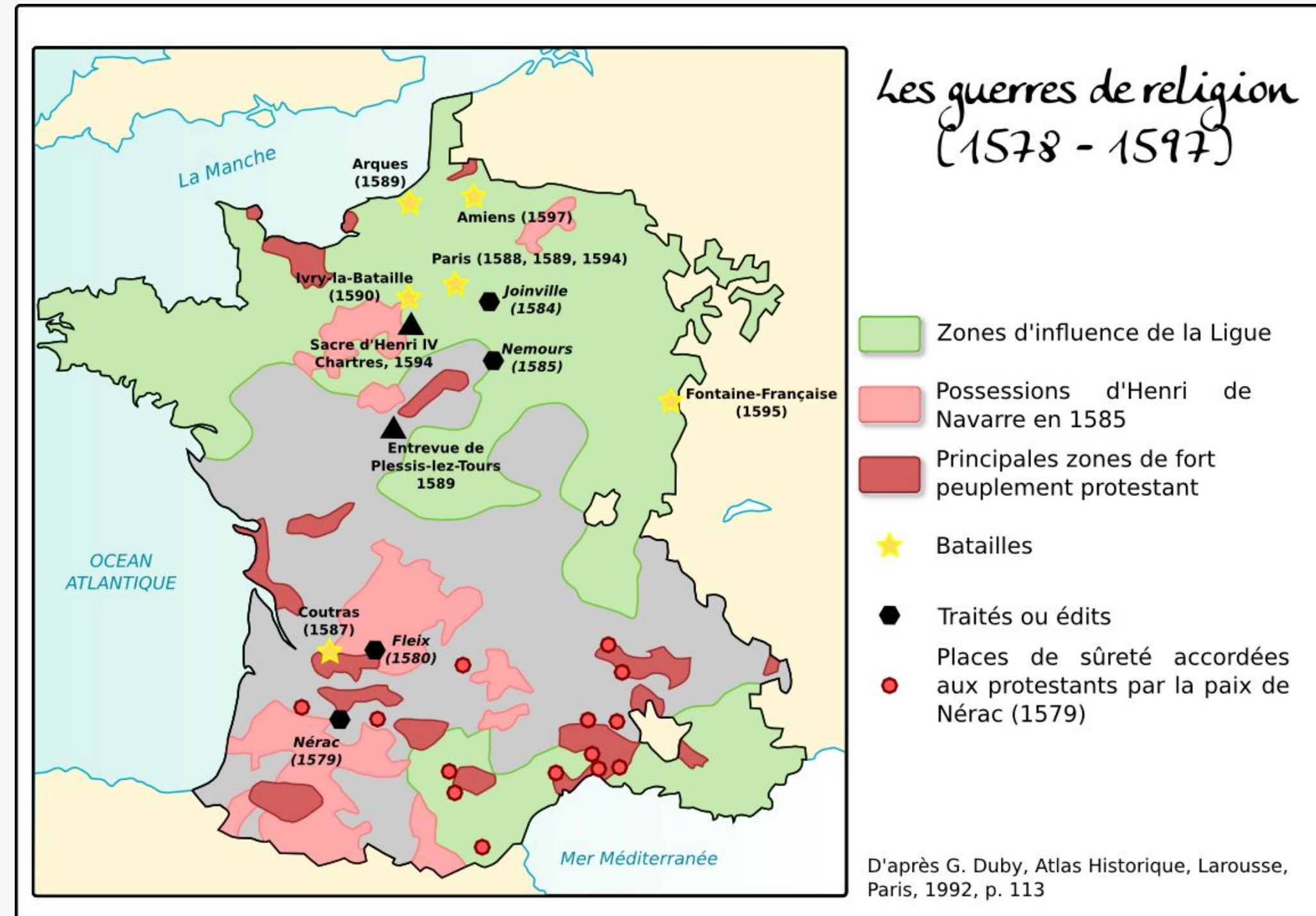
Jewish genealogy in France



- Three historical centers: Ashkenazi in Alsace, Jews of the Papal States, and Sephardim in Bordeaux
- Jews accorded full civil status following the Revolution
- Some records in *Archives Départementales* e.g. circumcisions in Lyon
- World War II: influx of Jewish refugees, internal displacement of Alsatians, Vichy/Nazi roundups resulting in thousands of deportations from Drancy
- Mémorial de la Shoah in Paris open to researchers
- Offline: the Préfecture de Paris
- Jewish sections in cemeteries in Paris and elsewhere

The Huguenots

- The Wars of Religion set the stage for migrations and recordkeeping issues
- The Desert, between the revocation of the Edict of Nantes (1685) and the Edict of Tolerance (Versailles, 1787)
- Founding settlements in New England and elsewhere

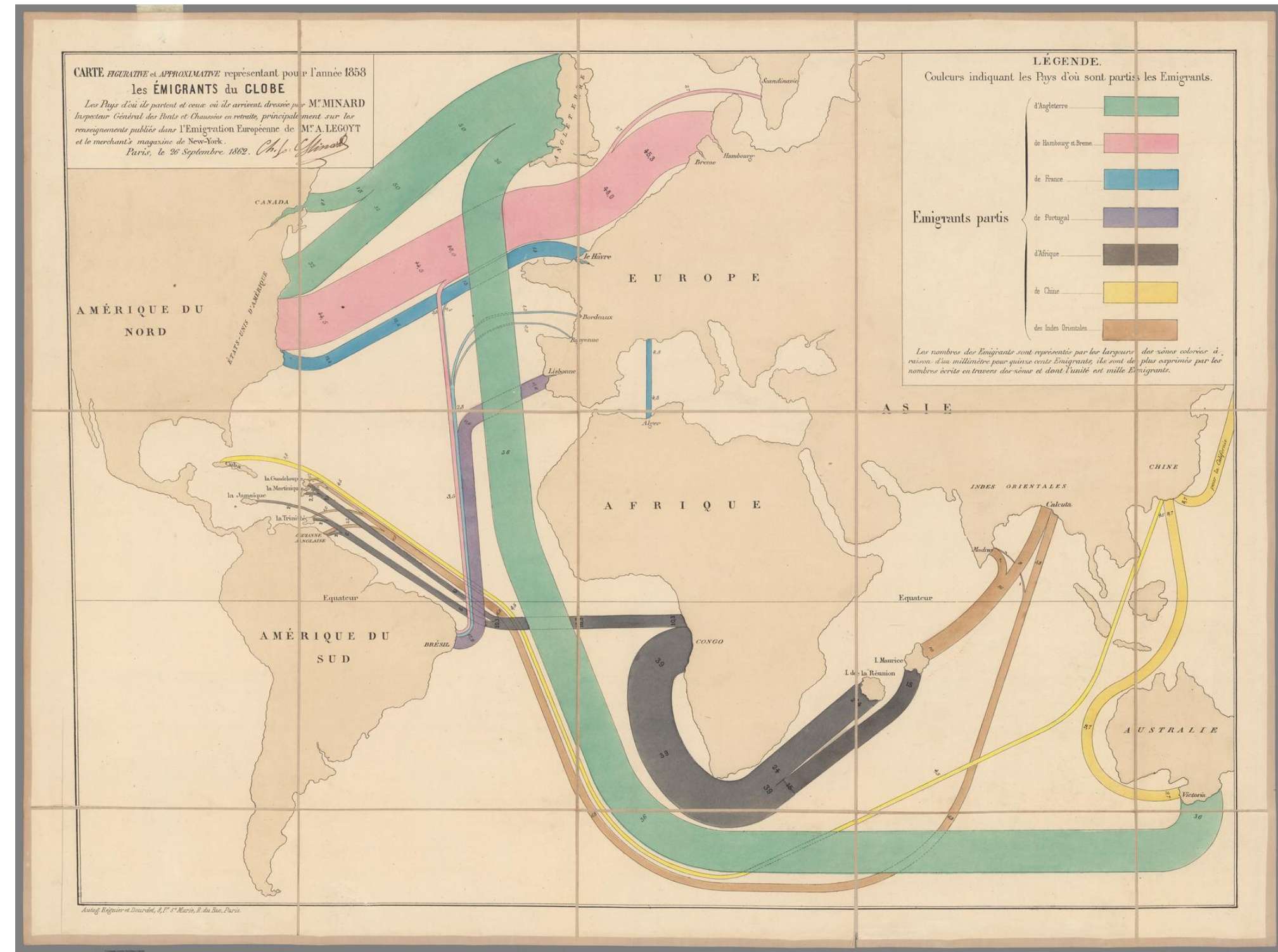

19th century emigration: mostly Europeans

- Germans, Alsatians, Swiss, Italians, Eastern Europeans
- Passenger lists: Few if any
- Le Havre: main port of emigration
- Cherbourg a major port after World War I
- Marseille: links to North African ports
- Dieppe: permanent ferry link to Newhaven, East Sussex (the mails!)
- Nantes, Bordeaux, Brest

Challenges in French genealogy

- Identifying the *département*
- Identifying the *commune* (town or village)
- Many *départements* have not been indexed yet -> look for sources in trees
- DNA testing for genealogy remains illegal, and that's unlikely to change anytime soon
- Strict privacy laws make finding living cousins quite difficult
- Destruction from wars: World War I, Normandy after D-Day, Paris in 1871
- Reading old handwriting!
