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
History of Voting in the United States

- **February 3, 1870**: The 15th Amendment to the United States Constitution prohibited the federal government and each state from denying a citizen the right to vote based on that citizen's "race, color, or previous condition of servitude."
- **1890s-1960s**: Jim Crow Laws restricted many African-American men from voting.
- Poll taxes
- Literacy tests
- Document requirements
- Grandfather clause for anyone who voted prior to 1867 didn't have to pay poll tax or take literacy test



History of Voting in the United States

- August 18, 1920: Women in the US were granted the right to vote by the 19th Amendment.
 - The amendment was first introduced in Congress in 1878
 - Nine western states adopted woman suffrage legislation by 1912
 - New York adopted woman suffrage in 1917
 - Tennessee became the 36th state to ratify the amendment on August 18, 1920
- August 6, 1965: Voting Rights Act passed prohibiting racial discrimination in voting.

- Why should you search Voter Records?
 - Fills in gaps between census years.
 - Replaces lost 1890 census.
 - Provides vital information.
 - Names including middle names
 - Dates
 - Residence
 - Naturalization
 - Nativity
 - Migration
 - May provide relationship information



Register of Naturalized Voters

- Cuyahoga County, Ohio, Board of Elections maintained a card file of naturalized registered voters.
- Provides the following information:
 - Name
 - Address
 - Ward/Precinct of the registered voter
 - Naturalization information
 - Location and date of the voter's naturalization
 - Their native land
 - Age when naturalized
 - Volume and page number of the naturalization documents
 - Additional residence information such as when and where they moved.




Poll Books - Ohio

- This page lists the 18 individuals who voted on 9 October 1821 and the results of the election.




- Newspapers often included voter registration lists.
- These lists contained information such as names and voter registration precincts.







- Poll taxes were assessments made on all residents living in an area.
- Most registered voters were required to pay this tax prior to being eligible to vote.
- In some areas there were grandfather rules that exempted people who had voted prior to 1867.








The Remarks section can often provide interesting information.



There may be multiple page types in Poll Tax Records.

- Assessment
- Errors
- Insolvent
- This is an error page indicating if individuals were assessed incorrectly or exempt from the tax.



- This is a List of Insolvent Polls for Barbour County,
 Alabama (1894), meaning these had not paid the poll tax and therefore were not eligible to vote.
- Lists name, race, and assessment amount.




