



History of Graves and Gravestones


- Burials have always existed
- Cost has always been a factor
- Burial pits
- Common graves



"They say you die twice. One time when you stop breathing and a second time, a bit later on, when somebody says your name for the last time"

Burial Records verses Gravestones

- Often Preferred
- Very little detail on burial records
- Burial date not death date
- No birth date
- Age not always included
- Other relatives
- Occupation





Graves with Stories

Recap

- Make sure you have the right Equipment
- Use mobile devices
- Always use Gravestones for dates of death
- Know your ancestor's religious beliefs
- Checkout other possible burial locations
- Check other graves around the location
- Look at records held in the church
- Ask church wardens
- Use websites
- Be mindful of transcriptions
- Look at original photos
- Try colour contrasts and filters
