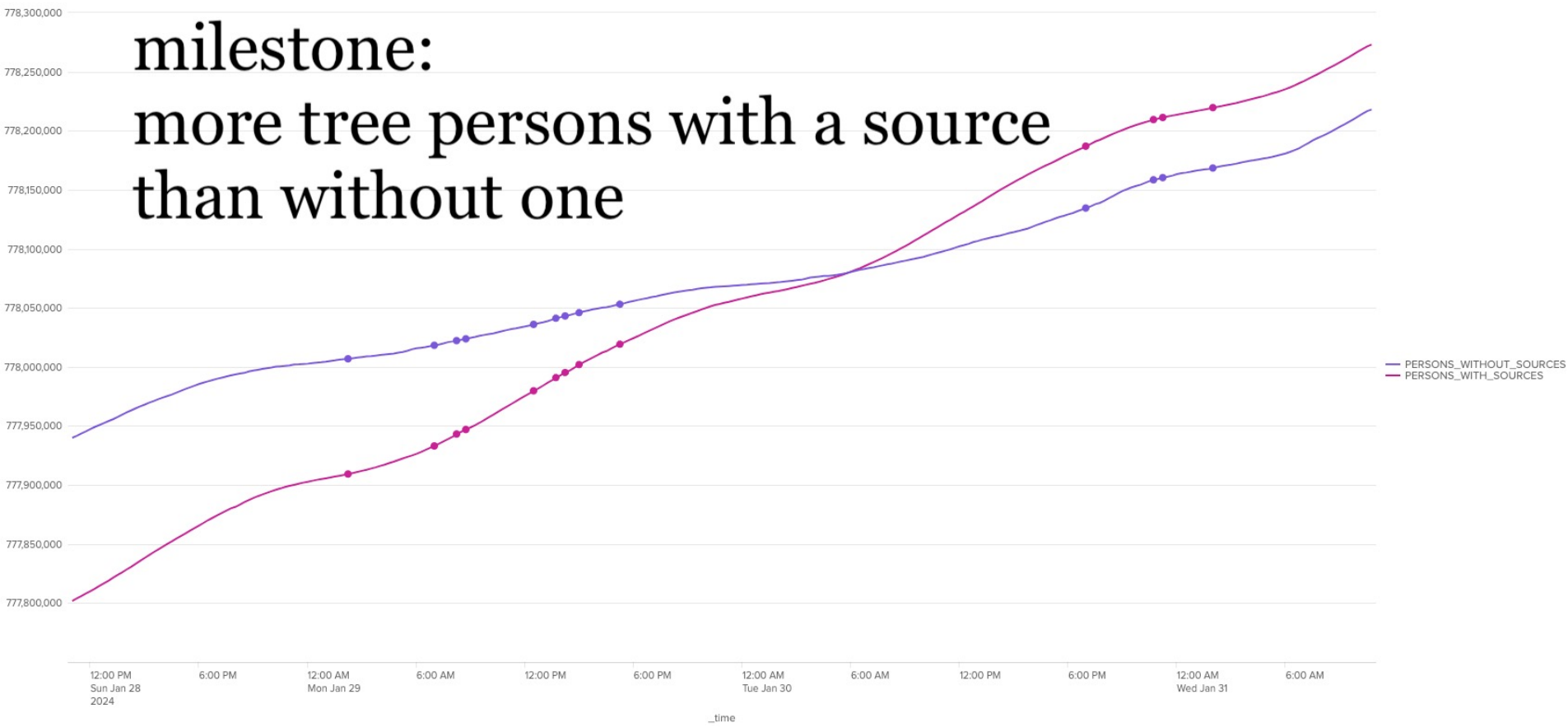

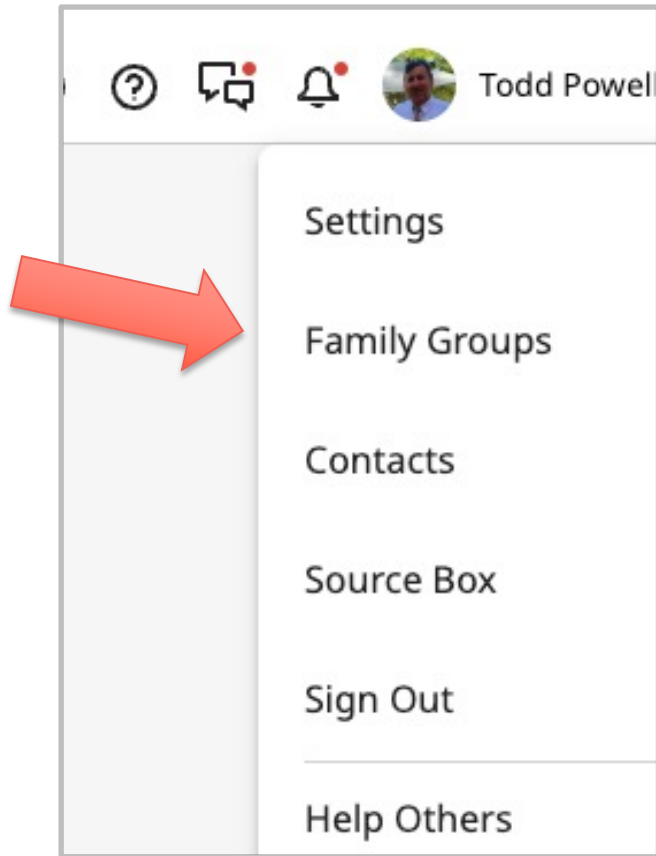

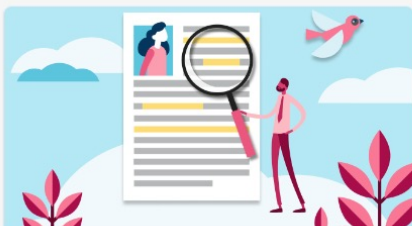

It is important to note that FamilySearch does not allow you to research ancestors or descendants who are still living, so it is recommended to start your tree with your nearest ancestors who have passed on [1]. As you enter more information, the website will help you construct your family tree [1]. Additionally, as your tree grows, you may be connected to information from other trees that also contain your ancestors [1].
